

Group Conscience Meeting Announcement

Our Group Service Representative, Doug B, WA, has called for a group conscience so that we may elect a new GSR and Alternate in alignment with the ISO's Annual Conference, which takes place in May.

The term would be June 2026 through May 2027.

The role of Group Service Representative is a service position where one member of the group is the main contact for the International Service Organization, or ISO of SAA. The GSR shares announcements and ISO communications with the group, attends monthly meetings with the Telemeeting Intergroup, and attends the periodic meetings for our assigned Area Assembly. These duties are not heavy and may involve at most a few hours a month. Intergroup and Area Assembly attendance might be shared between the GSR and the Alternate. The GSR and Alternate should meet the same criteria as our moderators, which are that they be working the 12 steps of SAA with a sponsor and have access to the Internet, an email account, and texting number.

If you feel called to service for our group, please let one of the moderators know before Monday so that we may put your name forward to the group. Doug is willing to serve as Alternate but we are looking for a new GSR for the current service year.

Also, the moderators group is reviewing the script for some necessary updates and a welcome change in how we handle our opening and closing prayer. You can read the draft script changes with explanation notes on the SAATalk.info website. Be sure to look up only the Monday entry for our meeting. That's where the script draft has been uploaded.
